Number, Amount and Type of Award:	Numbers not specified. Up to \$1,500.00 per recipient. Merit scholarship (Non-renewable).
Eligibility Requirements:	The applicant must be a: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Young Marine in good standing.• Young Marine for not less than two years.• Accepted to an accredited post-secondary educational institution, trade or technical school.
Financial Need:	Not Specified. Based on merit.
Method of Disbursement:	Payment is made directly to the school, on behalf of the recipient.
Application Process:	Application consists of a: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Standard Resume stating your objectives, qualifications, chronology of achievements inside and outside the Young Marines, hobbies and other interests• Cover letter addressed to the Young Marines National Executive Director, please include the name of your High School and the name of the college/ university or trade/technical school you wish to attend• Full-length photograph of applicant in the Young Marine uniform.• 500-word essay on how the Young Marines have influenced you.• Three letters of recommendation from a Young Marine Adult Leader, teacher or
