Title of Award:	Jimmy Trimble Scholarship
Area, Field of Study:	None specified. Applies to any accredited institution of higher education, trade or technical school.
Number, Amount and Type of Award:	Two scholarships per year \$1000.00 each One awarded to the outstanding male One awarded to the outstanding female Merit Scholarship.
Eligibility Requirements:	The applicant must be a: Young Marine in good standing. Young Marine for not less than three years. Graduating High School Senior.
Financial Need:	None specified. Based on Merit.
Method of Disbursement:	The Scholarships are presented at the annual American Veteran's Center Banquet.
Application Process:	Application consists of a: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Standard Resume stating your objectives, qualifications, chronology of achievements inside and outside the Young Marines, hobbies and other interests• Cover letter addressed to the Young Marines National Executive Director, please include the name of your High School and the name of the college/ university or trade/technical school you wish to attend• Full-length photograph of applicant in the Young Marine uniform.• 500-word essay on any World War II Marine and how this Marine has influenced you.
